<p>HOW TO REACH THE CITY?</p>	<p>The “Henri Coanda” - Otopeni international airport is 12 miles North from the centre of Bucharest and the city centre can be most comfortably reached by taxi. From the airport, a fare of approx. RON 80 is the equivalent in Romanian currency of about EUR 19.5. The ride takes around 45 minutes, depending on the traffic.</p> <p>When paying the taxi fare, please make sure that you have Romanian currency ready (not credit cards). In case you wish to call a taxi from any place in the city, the numbers of the most frequently used companies are (please dial with the prefix 021): 9440, 9441, 9451, 9791, 9425, 9444, 9488, 9466, 9477.</p> <p>As for the public transportation, bus #783 departs every half hour from the arrivals terminal towards downtown. The equivalent in Romanian currency is of about 1 EUR. Tickets can be purchased from the driver. Romanian currency is required.</p> <p>More information about transportation means from the airport to the hotel or to downtown Bucharest is available at: http://www.otp-airport.ro.</p>
<p>TRANSPORT</p>	<p>Public transportation (www.ratb.ro), including the subway (www.metrorex.ro), operates from 05:00 to 23:00. A two-ride ticket is about RON 3 (about EUR 0.7). Separate tickets for ground and underground transport are needed.</p>

Weather in Bucharest in May is pleasant, with temperatures around 19 degrees Celsius, sometimes warmer and some chances of rain showers.</p> <p>Romanian local time is GMT+2 hours.</p> <p>Romania uses 220 V, 50 Hz. Plugs are two-pin continental size.</p>
